Waskada Museum

The museum has had another successful year, ending with its annual meeting on Nov 25th.

The school reunion in June and the Brooks-Perrin family reunion in August were the highlights of the summer for the volunteers who enjoyed conducting tours and visiting with guests. Dan Meggison was able to fire up the forge in the Blacksmith Shop on both these occssions. Many memorable "discoveries" were made by the visitors as they viewed the displays. Thanks to the organisers of those events for allowing the museum to be a part of their celebrations.

The museum was open in July and August and by request for 64 days, and we were able to welcome about 200 visitors. Our sources of income were the Community Museums Grant (operating grant), the Canada Jobs Grant (summer student), admission fees and private donations.

We have completed the upgrading of the cataloguing system, done some repair work on the Blacksmith Shop, rearranged displays in Display Bldg #4, attended the Turtle Mountain Souris Plains Heritage Association annual meeting to discuss museum promotion on their website and attended the Westman Regional Museum meeting in Brandon where we shared successes and challenges with other museums.

Thanks to all the visitors, donors, and those who generously supported our Waskada Museum endowment fund, established through the Southwest Manitoba Regional Foundation and administered by The Wpg Foundation. We are almost at the end of the second year of the three-year program backed by the Manitoba govrnment.

All this support encourages the members of the museum committee to continue its efforts to provide a look into our past through our buildings and artifacts!
