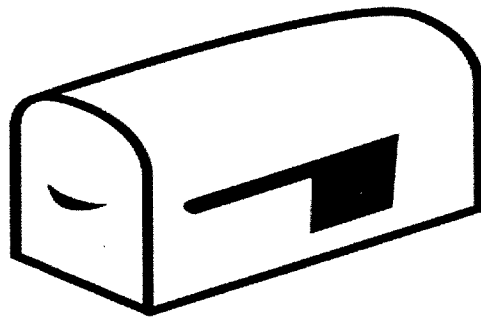

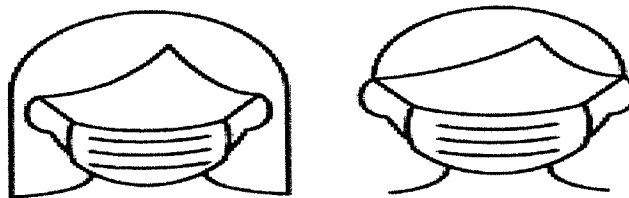

We ask that ratepayers who enter the office please use hand sanitizer.



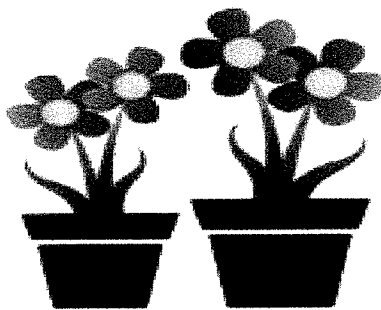
Face masks are optional.

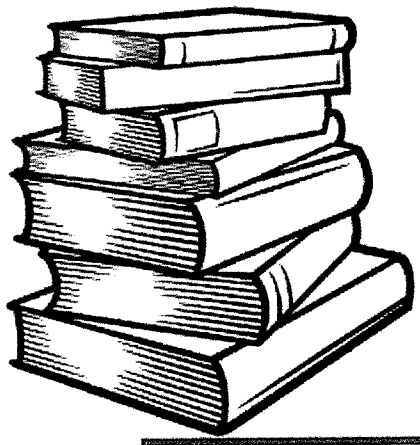

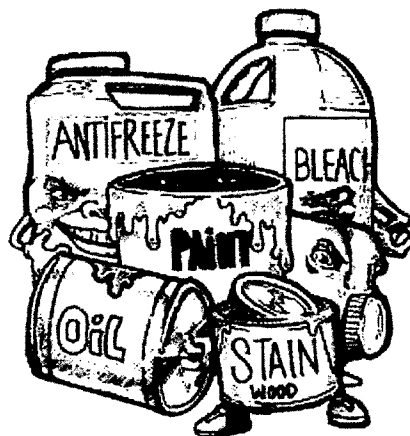
This Board meets every third Monday of the month and rotates between meetings in Melita and Pierson. If this opportunity is of interest to you, please contact Diane at the Municipal office.

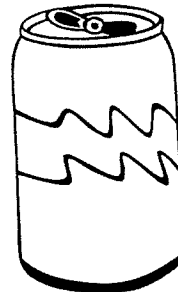

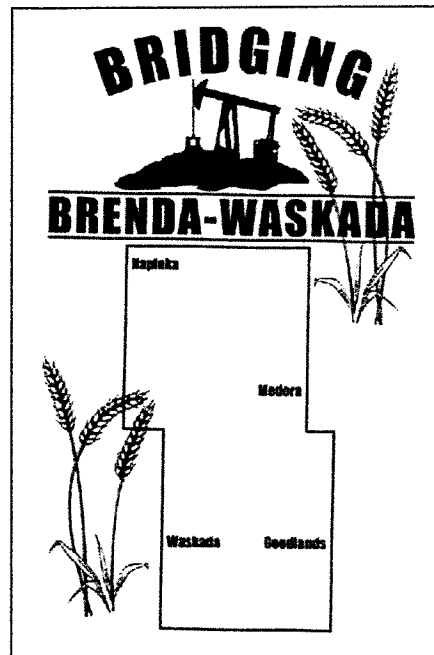

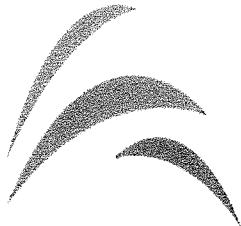
