Our next meeting is Jan 9.



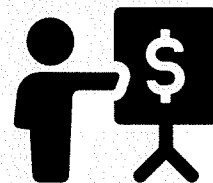

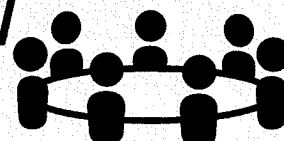

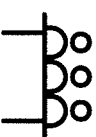
