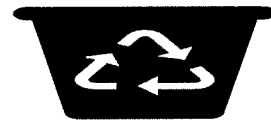

4. Metal Cans - rinsed, labels can be left on
5. Aluminum Drink Cans
6. Plastic Milk Jugs #2 - rinsed, lid removed, flatten
7. Plastic #1 (PETE) - rinsed, lids removed
8. Plastic #2, 4, 5, 7 (HDPE) - rinsed, lids removed  
#2 (HDPE) coloured - sorted separately

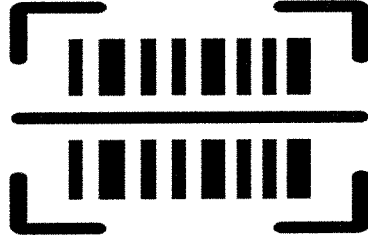
## **1. Download the Recycle Everywhere Mobile App**



## **2. Take a picture of your blue bin**

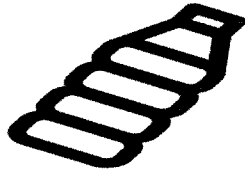
On the app, aim your camera at the blue bin you're using.





### **3. Scan the bar code on your empty beverage container**

On the app, adjust your camera to line up the bar code accordingly.



### **4. Drop your empty beverage container into your blue bin**

The most important step. Remember to always recycle after capturing your blue bin and bar code.

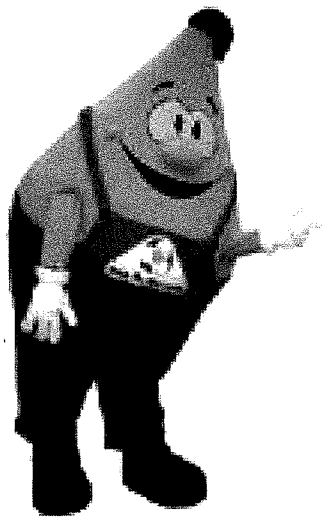

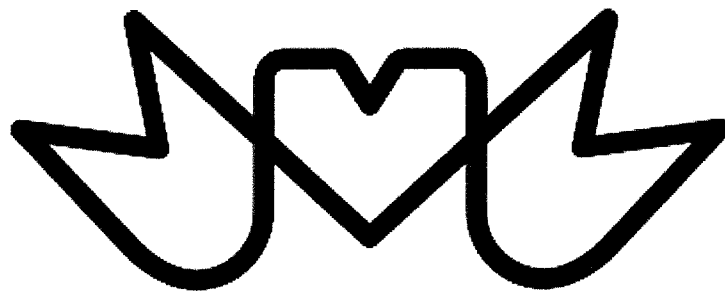

**Biography of Erica Lowe**

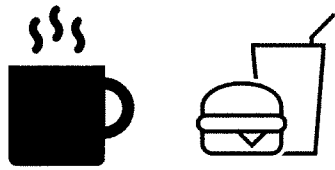

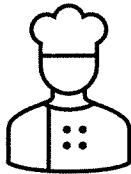




# Business opportunity:
