

- 1. Glass rinsed, lids removed, labels can be left on (in barrels)
- 2. Telephone Books (in separate box because of yellow pages)
- 3. Newspapers, flyers, office paper, envelopes, magazines, catalogues, shredded paper, books with hard covers removed
- 4. Metal Cans rinsed, labels can be left on
- 5. Aluminum Drink Cans
- 6. Plastic Milk Jugs #2 rinsed, lid removed, flatten
- 7. Plastic #1 (PETE) rinsed, lids removed
- 8. Plastic #2, 4, 5, 7 (HDPE) rinsed, lids removed #2 (HDPE) coloured sorted separately

#### **NOT** To Be Recycled:

- -Cardboard boxes, including juice boxes, milk cartons, cereal boxes
- -#3, #6 Plastic
- -Plastic bags
- -Tinfoil
- -Motor Oil Containers (these need to go to Eco Centre at landfill site)
