









4. Metal Cans - rinsed, labels can be left on
5. Aluminum Drink Cans
6. Plastic Milk Jugs #2 - rinsed, lid removed, flatten
7. Plastic #1 (PETE) - rinsed, lids removed
8. Plastic #2, 4, 5, 7 (HDPE) - rinsed, lids removed
#2 (HDPE) coloured - sorted separately
