



2020 and 2021 Deloraine & Area Christmas Cheer Report

2020 Cheer

Due to Mb.Public Health covid restrictions last year, Deloraine & Area did not have a wrap up meeting last spring. 2020 was a challenging year to make plans for receiving physical donations of food and gifts as well as assembling in person for putting the hampers together and delivering. It was a relief to find out that providing a service like Cheer was considered essential and that Harvest Community Church, where Cheer works out of, was able to allow us to use the space. It was an extraordinary year all around but donations were generous! The Cheer committee learned there were many solutions of arranging work times, self-distancing and other tasks of Cheer workdays. Some extra thoughtfulness was appreciated in donations of hand sewn face masks and hand sanitizer.

41 hampers were delivered, 10 of the hampers were donated. The hampers included 49 children.

2021 Cheer

A big thank you to Waskada community for each cash, food and gift donation generously given to fill the hampers! As well as many personal cash donations, Cheer is very grateful for the financial support from Waskada Sunrise Credit Union and The Mall In the Rink committee (silver collection at the door).

44 hamper requests were met this year. The hampers included 42 children.


The Cheer Committee filled 34 hampers and 10 were adopted out. Cheer supplies the turkey (or other meat) for every hamper. Hampers also include non-perishable food items, fresh produce, bread, margarine and milk/juice for hamper families with children. Each child receives a gift as well as knit wear/outer winter wear (hats / toques, scarves, mittens/gloves and socks).

10 hampers were adopted; the adopted hamper donators work with our referral co-ordinator so that all the basic items of food and gifts/knitwear (for children) are supplied. All adopted hampers are brought to Cheer and delivered. The adopted hampers provided gifts etc for 24 children.

In recognition of the monetary cost of supplying a hamper, adopted hamper donators were asked to send receipts for their purchases and a tax receipt was issued.

Cheer hamper trivia....fresh produce supplied to the hampers is potatoes, carrots and onions. Apples and mandarin oranges are also put in the hampers. In 2021, the approximate weight of produce was 845 lbs!!






