2022 Dust Control Program

The Municipality will be taking applications for our annual dust control treatment program. The price of dust control treatment is \$0.34/L . Council will pay 50% of the dust suppressant application fee. Please contact the Municipal office if you want dust control application.

Elections

The Municipal elections will take place on October 26, 2022. Our Municipality will be holding elections for 1 Head of Council and 6 members of Council. This includes 2 councilors for Ward 5, Waskada. The campaign and candidate registration period begins May 1, 2022, for Head of Council and June 30, 2022, for Councilors. If you wish to submit your name for candidacy, please fill in the election form available at the Municipal office. The deadline for submissions is Tuesday, September 20, 2022.

Please ensure that your voters' information is current and correct to verify your eligibility to vote. Voting officials will also be required for this election. If you are interested or require further election information, please contact the election official at the Municipal Office.



Southwest Planning District

A plan was created by the four Municipalities including Brenda-Waskada, Town of Melita, Deloraine-Winchester, and Two Borders. The consultant Richard and Windtrup has been consulted to provide an update review of the Municipal By-Laws as a review completed by the Province of Manitoba and Community Planning. The first draft is in revision to enact By-laws according to provincial regulations.

Southwest Recreation

The Municipality of Brenda-Waskada has decided to start its own recreation programming apart from Antler River Recreation. Ideas for recreation programming are welcome. The Waskada Athletic Club has started youth soccer in the Municipality. The Municipality has a variety of activities planned for the summer months. Please stay tuned.

Crocus Country Economic Development Corporation

The Crocus Country Economic Development Corporation is a partnership between the Municipality of Brenda-Waskada, Municipality of Two Borders and the Town of Melita, to help businesses grow and stay in the region and to build community capacity to sustain growth and development. The corporation most recent accomplishment is a Class 1 Training Project. Partnership with Vandaele Seeds in Medora made it possible to host a 6 Week course. Building and Development Permits

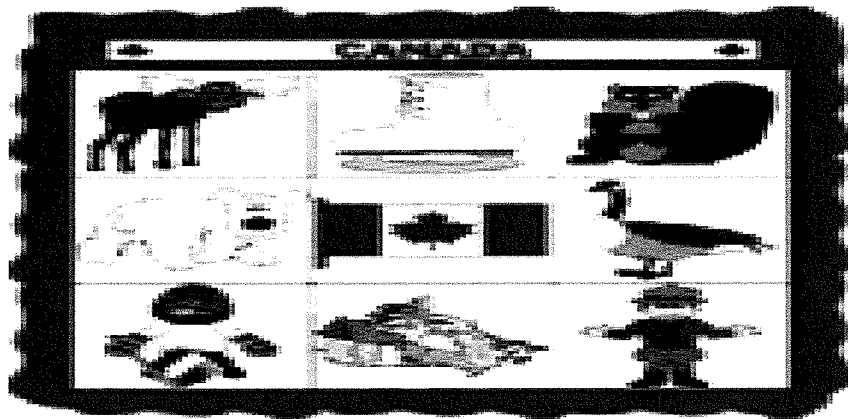
