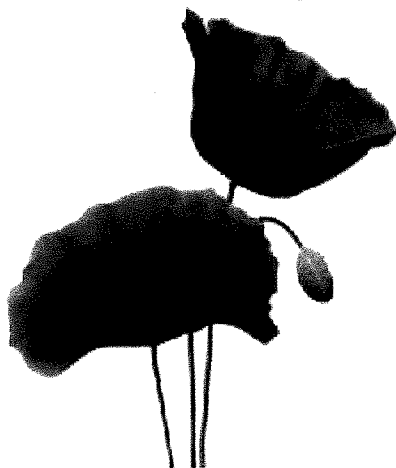

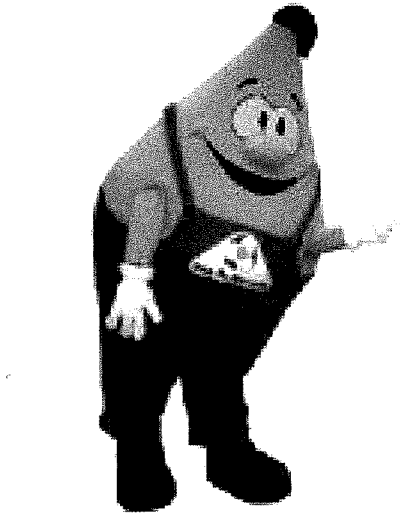

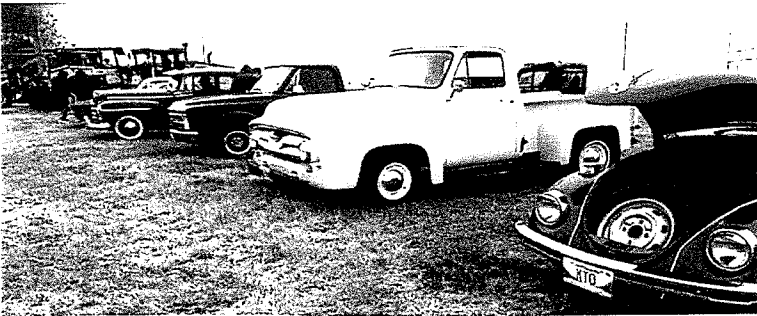

Thank you to the community members and families who raise funds for cancer research.

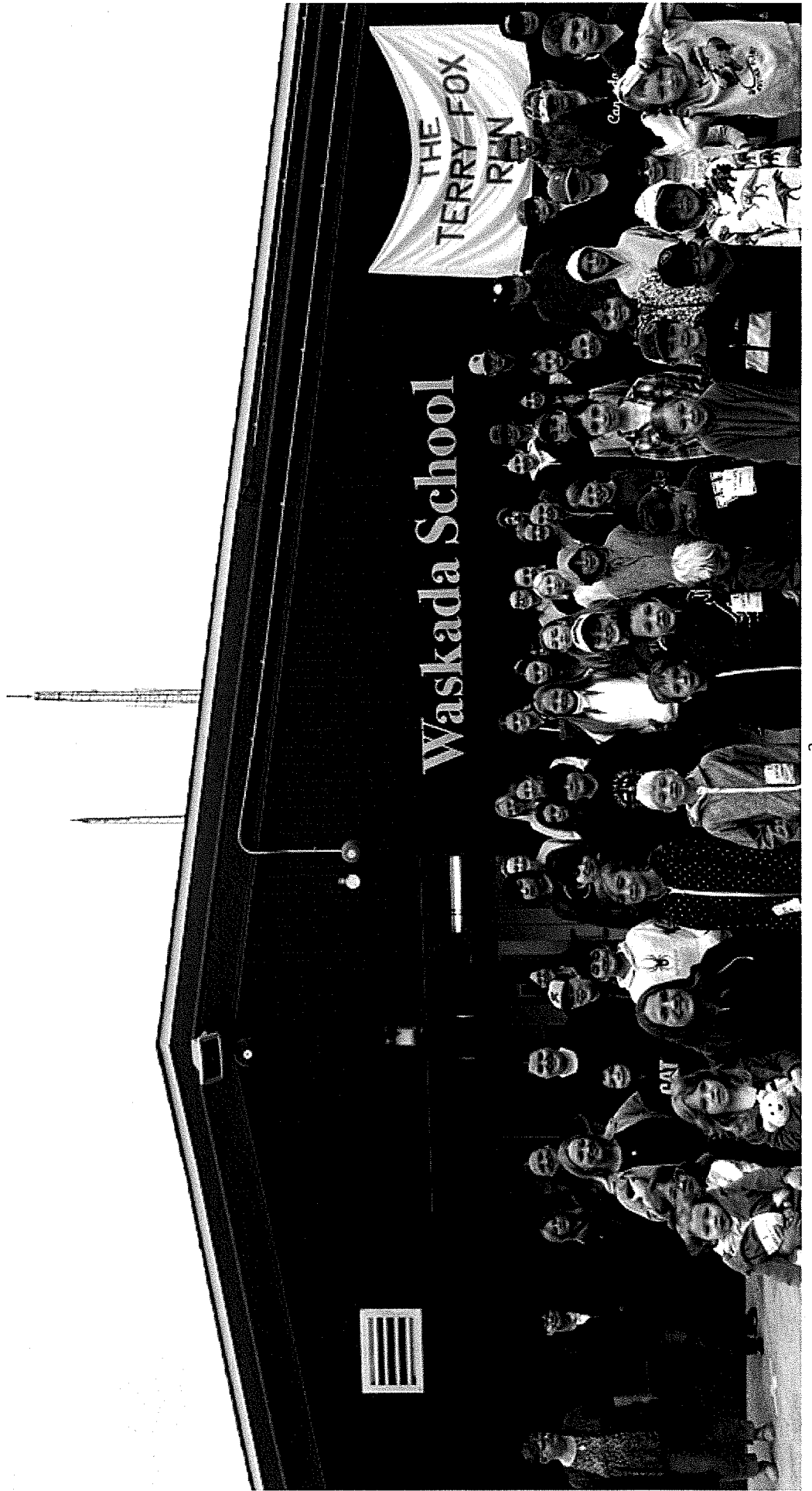
