NHL HAT AUCTION PAYOUT

The Waskada Wee Ones hat auction was a resounding success in year 2. All 32 NHL teams were put up for auction and purchased anywhere from \$125 to \$1,175 per team. \$5,300 was raised for the daycare from the sale of those 32 teams. Aside from the top overall team which was over pretty early, the races were exciting right until the end of the regular season. There were 5 payouts awarded to 5 different teams this season. Top regular season record (\$796.88) belonged to the Boston Bruins (Trent King), top Canadian team (\$796.88) belonged to the Toronto Maple Leafs (Griffith Agencies), 17th place (\$796.88) belonged to the Calgary Flames (Radcliffe Auctioneering), last place team (\$796.88) belonged to the Anaheim Ducks (Jared Spence), and finally the Stanley Cup Winner (\$2,125) belonged to the Vegas Golden Knights (Stovan Oilfield). Stovan Oilfield owned two teams and both of those teams (Vegas and Florida) were in the Stanley Cup Finals!! Thank you to all who participated in this fundraiser and supported the daycare. 





Melita & Area Health Auxiliary Scholarship

The Melita and Area Health Auxiliary will award a \$600 scholarship to one deserving student upon proof of acceptance for their second or current successive year of post-secondary studies OR upon proof of graduation from a shorter course (equal to or less than one year) in some field of human care medicine. Included, but not limited to nurse, physician, EMT, optometrist, dentist, x-ray technician, physiotherapist, occupational therapist, lab technician, medical records, etc.

To Qualify:

o They must live in the Melita Hospital District: which includes the Town of Melita, the R.M. of Two Borders, Townships 3 & 4, Range 25 of Brenda and all the villages and towns within the above areas, including Waskada for the last 5 years as of time of application.

Application should include:

- o Name, contact address, email and current phone number
- o Field of medicine chosen
- o Reasons for pursuing career
- o Details of why you should be considered for this scholarship
- o Details of volunteer work (which is UNPAID and NOT related to any school course for any kind of mark or credit) carried out in a hospital, personal care home or assisted living facility
- Other volunteer community work (same definition of volunteer work as noted above)

Please detail the above requirements on a separate sheet of paper.

Attach to Application:

- o Transcript of most recent year of post-secondary study OR proof of completion/graduation of a one year (or less) study program.
- o If applicable, proof of acceptance into second (or next) year of current course
