The Manitoba Farmer Wellness Program is an initiative aimed at providing mental health support for farmers and their families. It has been designed to provide one on one, no cost, confidential counseling sessions by professional counselors with a background in agriculture.

#### Why it's important that we talk

#### As stress builds:

- expectations for us and for others increase
- coping mechanisms are not healthy
- it leads to strained relationships
- making mistakes in business
- distractions that can cause serious injuries.

#### Being proactive and reaching out can:

- help in better coping skills
- keep us safer
- improve relationships
- better management decisions
- decrease conflicts

#### Manitoba Farmer Wellness Program

 Who can access this service? This program is available to Manitoba farmers and their immediate family members. Participants must be 16 years of age or older to access services. If you have concerns for youth or children, please contact your Regional Health Authority Mental Health intake line. This number is listed on our Crisis Services page.

How do I find a counsellor that will help with my concerns? It's easy! Simply click on the 'Book an appointment' link on this site and answer a few questions. A counsellor will respond to you within two working days to book a time that is convenient for you.

I'm worried someone might find out I'm using the service. Is it confidential? Yes! We understand the importance of having a safe place to share. Your counsellor is a professional and therefore required to maintain confidentiality. Everything said in sessions stays between the two of you, just like a doctor is required to keep your records private.

I don't want to talk on the phone or see someone online. Can I meet someone in person? We want people to feel comfortable when they reach out. The program will attempt to accommodate in-person requests on a case-by-case basis. Depending on where the counsellor resides and the location of the client, in person sessions may or may not be available.

What if I don't find my counsellor helpful or have a personal connection to the counsellor? Feeling comfortable and at ease with your counsellor is especially important. If you wish to speak with another counsellor, we will do our best to accommodate your request.

What if I want to continue seeing my counsellor after my six sessions have ended? The Manitoba Farm Wellness Program offers up to six sessions at no cost to the client. If you require more time, please discuss this option with the counsellor. Depending on your counsellors availability, you may continue seeing them and paying directly for their services based on their hourly rates.

What if I need to speak with someone immediately or in between sessions? If you are in need of immediate assistance, go directly to your local emergency department or call 911. This program offers support and counselling by appointment only.

- Counsellors do not have the capacity to respond to crisis situations. Please refer to the crisis resource list on this site.
- I'm worried about a family member and want them to see a counsellor. Can you reach out to them? The MFWP is a voluntary service. Anyone wishing to utilize the services will be required to reach out themselves by using the 'Book an Appointment' link. If they have questions, please refer them to the FAQ page, or contact us by using the general Inquiries box.

I have never talked to a counsellor before and not sure where to start? What can I expect? It's not uncommon to feel a bit nervous the first time. It's an important step towards improving your mental health and shows that you are willing to make choices to improve your situation. Your counsellor is there to support and listen to you. They will not judge you or the choices you have made.
