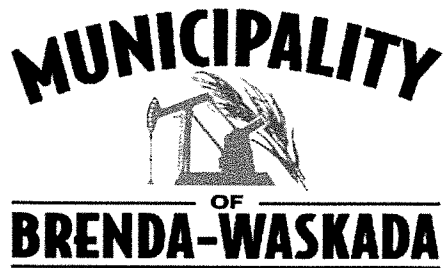

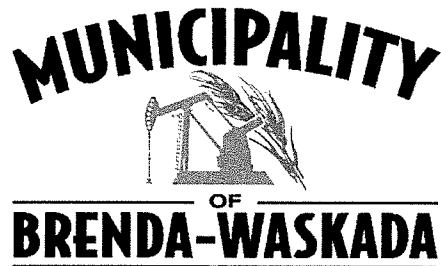

2024 GRAVEL HAULING TENDERS

Tenders will be accepted by the Municipality of Brenda-Waskada for their 2024 Graveling Programs. Tenders will be awarded for a one-year term. Pit registration fees and rehab levies to be the responsibility of the hauler or pit owner. Road graveling program to be completed no later than July 1.

Gravel programs may include gravel stockpiling and are not limited to road graveling.

Each tender shall include the following information:

- A breakdown of the price per cubic yard mile hauled; minimum haul mileage; loading charge per cubic yard; and any other charges, taxes; and a total price.
- A copy of letter of good standing with MB WCB and a copy of your COR certificate.
- A list of equipment/machinery that will be used.

The Foreman of the Municipality oversees all gravel programs. Gravel trucks must reduce speed when meeting vehicles on the road and going past farmyards. Please contact Ray Aitchison, Foreman (204 522-5131) for gravel stockpile locations and details for the gravel programs.

All gravel programs are subject to change at any time at the discretion of the Municipal Foreman.

Sealed tenders must be received by the undersigned no later than 4:00 P.M. on April 12, 2024, and marked "Gravel Tender". Lowest or any tender not necessarily accepted, and the Council reserves the right to reject any or all tenders. Further information may be obtained by contacting the undersigned.

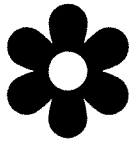
