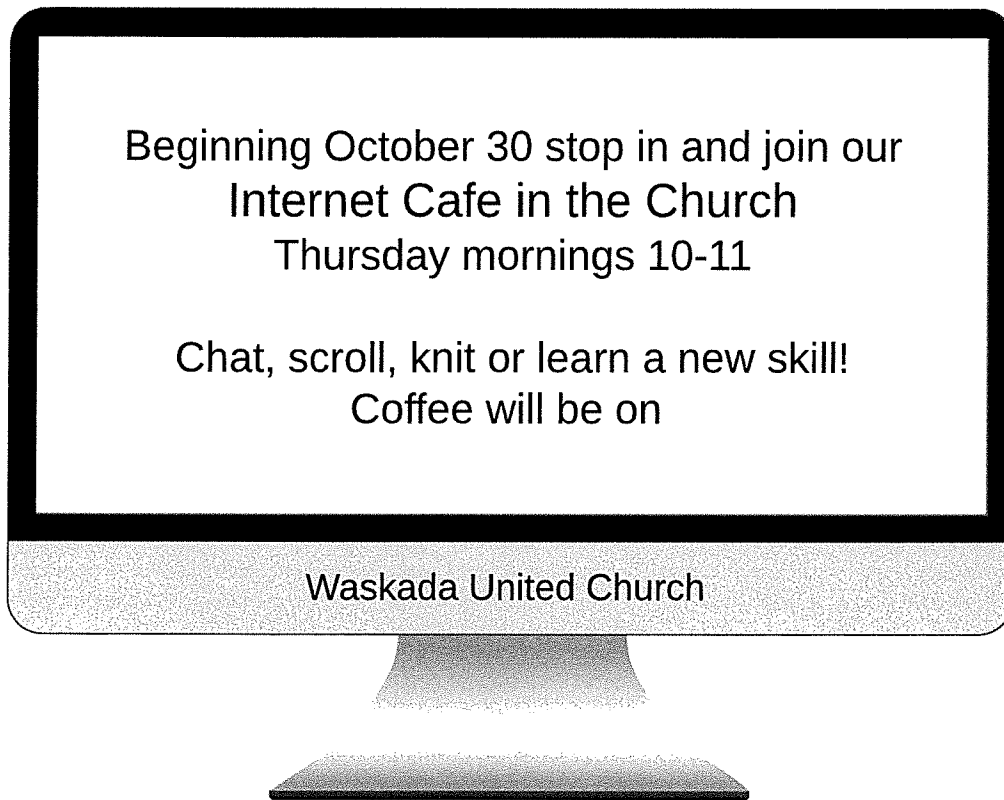

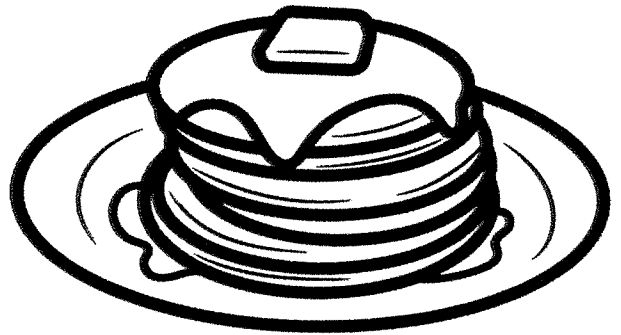

Senior Election Official (SEO)

Municipality of Brenda-Waskada

The Municipality of Brenda-Waskada is accepting applications for the position of **Senior Election Official (SEO)**.

The next municipal election is October 2026.

Position Overview:

The SEO is appointed by municipal council and is responsible for the general direction and supervision of the municipal election process. This includes ensuring compliance with all relevant legislation, managing election logistics, and maintaining the integrity of the electoral process.

Key Responsibilities:

- Interpret and apply The Municipal Act and relevant election regulations.
- Prepare and maintain the list of voters.
- Provide public notice of nominations and elections.
- Receive and verify nomination papers.
- Appoint and train election officials.
- Establish and equip voting places.
- Oversee advance voting and election day operations.
- Ensure proper vote counting and reporting of results.
- Conduct by-elections if required.

Qualifications:

- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and exercise sound judgment.
- Familiarity with municipal governance and election procedures.
- Must be non-partisan and maintain confidentiality.
- Previous experience in election administration is an asset.

Term & Compensation:

- Appointment begins upon passing of a council bylaw.
- Hours vary, with peak activity in the months leading up to and during the election (typically Sept–Oct).
- Compensation dependent on skills and experience.
